

## **Psychology Intern Boys & Girls Club**

The Boys & Girls Club continues to work to be an inclusive environment for all youth ages K-12. We are hoping that by bringing in a Psychology Intern, we can help to provide more one-on-one interaction with some of our members who have special needs/behavioral issues that we otherwise have been unable to fully support due to lack of staff and funding. This intern would need to develop and create a record log of all behavioral issues that they work with. They would then assess what corrective actions if any could be taken and implemented specific to both the youth and behavioral issue, along with the outcomes of the behavior management plan. The ideal candidate would engage with the youth on a day to day basis and be available to youth who seek help. Individuals would need a background in Psychology or Sociology. ### **Psych at Sites/Clubhouse:**

- Interact and get to know the clients and youth you would be working with. This may involve integrating yourself through participation in order to build relationships with the members.
- Interns will then work one-on-one with several clients helping to proactively manage behavioral issues as well as report on the day-to-day interaction with the clients, interns will have access and training from a behavioral specialist with 30 plus years of experience.
- Interns will need to keep specific record logs for each client to assess progress over the time frame of the term. Progress reports will be due.
- Interns may use IEP's associated with clients in order to manage behavioral issues more effective from the classroom setting to the afterschool program.
- Perform evaluations of site and self with Program Coordinator, as well as overall internship experience
